This applicant must be accepted into graduate school, defined as a graduate or professional degree level program at an accredited school. Applicant must have an undergraduate degree with an average GPA of 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale. Applicant must demonstrate superior leadership qualities, show a commitment to move to the Monroe, Wisconsin area and have the desire and ability to transform the Monroe area into a better place to live and work.

You must include the following materials with your application:

- Proof of high school graduation or GED
- Verification of undergraduate degree and GPA
- Verification of current graduate school GPA, if applicable
- Verification of graduate/professional degree program acceptance
- Copy of tuition bill for the first scholastic period. This may be furnished upon receipt by the scholarship recipient.
- Completed application form and essay questions.
- Provide three references that the Committee may contact. Only one reference may be a direct relative.

If requested, you must conduct an interview with the Selection & Oversight Committee.
